
THE SIZE OF PATTERN REPEAT:

SCALE 1:1 (real size)

RESOLUTION 300 DPI

A PATTERN REPEAT IS A REPETITIVE FRAGMENT OF A PATTERN THAT CAN BE REPRODUCED ON ANY PLANE, PROVIDING THE IMPRESSION OF A SINGLE ENTITY.

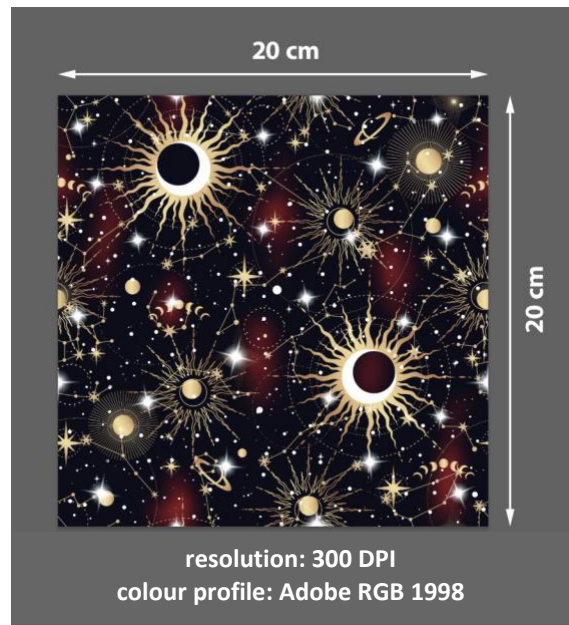
COLOUR SPACE:

RGB - Adobe RGB colour profile

FILE FORMATS:

TIF, EPS, PDF, the **JPG** format is acceptable but it should be noted that JPG format is saved with lossy compression, what affects the quality of designed graphics.

TIF is the safest format for printing - we suggest that the customer's patterns be designed in this format.



GRAPHIC FILES MUST NOT CONTAIN:

(in raster images: **TIF, JPG**) - layers, paths, masks or transparency channels,

(in vector images: **EPS, PDF**) - special effects not converted into objects, fonts in the original format (fonts shall be converted into objects).

If in doubt, a vector project should be generated as a raster file.

ATTENTION!

IF A SUPPLIED FILE CONTAINS A NON-STANDARD ELEMENT (REGISTRATION MARKS, COLOUR WEDGES, PUNCH ELEMENTS AND THE LIKE), INFORM THE PRINTER THAT SUCH AN ELEMENT IS AN INTEGRAL PART OF THE PRINTING PATTERN.

fill in the order form,

be the copyright owner of the commissioned work (a necessary prerequisite),

prepare files for printing according to the guidelines provided,

determine parameters, such as bleeds and the overall layout of the individual works,

In case of any doubts about the colours or quality of the supplied files, it shall be necessary to have a sample print made - such an order extends the lead time.

provide virus-free files.

The JANIS Company shall not be responsible for the contents of commissioned works.

Any corrections and preparations of patterns for printing shall be chargeable services.

Print pattern projects, commissioned to JANIS, shall be priced individually.

The ordering party shall be held fully liable for any legal defects in the form and/or content of the works delivered to be printed and for patterns, made to their order, as well as for any infringement of copyright or of other rights of third parties.
